ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

We are aware that our attitude towards the environment also affects the quality of life of future generations. That is why we are committed to protecting the environment through our activities, and we emphasize above all the elements that define sustainable care for the environment.

CORE OBJECTIVES

To develop and produce transformers with minimum impact on the environment as possible, considering the principles of sustainability.

- ✦ To improve the EMS with the aim of reducing the impact of our activities on the environment.
- ✦ Identify the significant environmental aspects, measure their effects on the environment and, when necessary, act.
- ✦ Implement a company culture based on ESG principles.
- ✦ To record the consumption of resources, energy and CO₂ emissions and take measures how to reduce them.
- ✦ Increase the share of waste materials for reuse.
- ✦ Implement the controlled decomposition of transformers at the end of their service life and ensure recycling of used materials as far as possible.

RESPONSIBILITY OF MANAGEMENT

In order to continually reduce environmental impact, the company's management is responsible for:

- ✦ makes strategic decisions to reduce the environmental footprint by integrating environmental aspects and circular economy principles into the company's business process,
- ✦ Implementation of activities to achieve the objective of the Environmental Policy goals set out in the company's strategy and annual plans,
- ✦ compliance with requirements of legislation and other environmental regulations as well as relevant environmental requirements of clients and other interested parties,
- ✦ raises environmental awareness among all employees and those involved in the company's business process,
- ✦ enables education, training and competence of employees for responsible management of the environment,
- ✦ the provision of financial and other resources for the implementation of environmental and sustainability programs.
